**CRIME AND PUNISHMENT HELD OVER BY POPULAR DEMAND!
The Gamm extends New England Premiere**

PAWTUCKET, RI (September 27, 2005) — The Sandra Feinstein-Gamm Theatre (The Gamm) is pleased to announce an extension of its season opener, *Crime and Punishment*, due to vigorous ticket sales, including several sold-out shows. The critically and popularly acclaimed staging of this thrilling, fast-paced adaptation was scheduled to close following an Oct. 9 matinee performance.
