**SINGER/SONGWRITER SEAN KANE TO PERFORM TRADITIONAL MUSIC CONCERT
TO BENEFIT THE GAMM THEATRE**

The Sandra Feinstein-Gamm Theatre is pleased to present a concert by guitarist and singer/songwriter Sean Kane to benefit the theater. The concert coincides with the release of Kane's first CD, *A Nation of One*. The two-hour concert will take place on **Monday, April 17 at 7 p.m.** at The Gamm Theatre, 172 Exchange St., Pawtucket, RI. **Proceeds from ticket sales will go toward The Gamm's artistic and educational programming.**

Kane will be performing tunes from his new CD, which he described as "acoustic folk rock songs, inspired by the Irish and American traditional sound."

Area musicians performing with Kane will include Massachusetts fiddler **Amy Basse**; singer and actress **Katherine Joy**; and tin whistle and bazouki player **Stu Peak**. All have played with Kane as participants in the **Blackthorne session out of Brennans Grille & Tavern in South Easton, Mass.**

Brennan's, previously called the **Blackthorne Tavern**, has been a premier music venue for 20 years, hosting many of the area's finest traditional musicians and veterans of sessions throughout Southern New England. In honor of the **Blackthorne Session's 10th anniversary**, Kane's concert will be followed immediately by a **rousing Celtic session**. **Actress and Gamm Artistic Associate Jeanine Kane** will accompany her husband onstage for several songs. She also performs on the new CD.

Tickets are \$10. Please call **401-723-4266** to purchase with a credit card. Tickets will also be available at the door. Seating is limited to 125 and is general admission. About Sean Kane

Sean has been a musician since he was seven years old. He played classical and jazz trumpet throughout high school, performing solo trumpet as the then-youngest member of the nationally known Brockton High School jazz band. As a guitarist and singer, Sean started playing out at Tommy McGann's Irish Embassy, south of Boston. In 1997, he founded the Blackthorne Tavern seisiun (Irish for "session") in South Easton, Mass. Sean has played with or opened for Liam Clancy, Robbie O'Connell, Jez Lowe and the Bad Pennies, Teada, Gaelic Storm, Liz Carroll and John Doyle, among others. His first CD, *A Nation of One*, will be released by Arise! Records this March. Sean is dean of students at Norton High School. He lives in Easton, Mass., with his wife, Gamm Artistic Associate Jeanine Kane, and their daughters, Brigid and Fiona.
