IT'S A WONDERFUL LIFE: A LIVE RADIO PLAY RETURNS TO THE GAMM STAGE!

WARWICK, RI (October 31, 2022) — **The Sandra Feinstein-Gamm Theatre** (The Gamm) brings audiences home for the holidays with a limited run of *It's A Wonderful Life: A Live Radio Play*. Adapted by **Joe Landry** from the screenplay by **Frances Goodrich**, **Albert Hackett**, **Frank Capra** and **Jo Swerling**, this acclaimed twist on the classic film runs from **Dec. 9-24 only**. The production marks the theater's fourth year retelling this redemptive story of resilience and community as if from an actual radio station on Christmas Eve in 1946.

Gamm Artistic Director Tony Estrella remounts this year's show, originally directed by Damon Kiely, and passes the role of George Bailey to Gamm veteran actor Jeff Church after three years performing the beloved character. With a cast of seven actors playing multiple characters, an onstage Foley artist creating real-time sound effects, and a sprinkling of customized radio jingles, It's A Wonderful Life: A Live Radio Play promises once again to make "something so well-known and recognizable feel so fresh and new."
