HONOREE ELIZA GREENE CHACE COLLINS

Tonight The Gamm Theatre honors Eliza Greene Chace Collins with **The David Wax Award for Outstanding Commitment to the Arts**.

Eliza served on The Gamm's Board of Directors for an unprecedented 15 consecutive years beginning in 2006. She served as secretary for 10 of those 15 years, seeing The Gamm through its formative years as it became Rhode Island's second year-round professional theater.



A Rhode Island native, Eliza was born in Providence and attended The Wheeler School. She then went on to Barnard College in New York and received her Masters in Philosophy from Trinity College in Ireland. Eliza later received a second Masters degree in Theatre from Brown University in 2002.

Eliza worked as an Editor for both the Smithsonian Astrophysical Observatory's publication department, as well as for the Harvard Business Review. She has served on numerous boards, including the Woman's Resource Center of South County, South County Hospital, and the Cambridge Arts Council.

Eliza is a published author, with her work being featured in publications such as the Harvard Business Review and Harper's Bazaar. She has written five books on business and two novels, as well as two original plays that were performed at The Barker Playhouse in Providence, RI. Most recently Eliza has written two one-woman shows performed here in RI in 2020, 2021, & 2022.

Eliza continues to lead by example as both an advocate of the arts and as an artist herself. **Congratulations Eliza!**




